PROPOSED VISIT TO HINDU SOCIETY TEMPLE, PRESTON

In conjunction with our class studies this term it is proposed that Year 2 will be visiting the South Meadow Lane Temple in Preston on Wednesday 1st July 2015. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and will return before the school lunch period commences. Our transport will be Redline Travel, Penwortham.

The children will be able to watch from the back of the Temple a service taking place showing them some Hindu worship rituals. Following this, there will be a guided tour of the Hindu Temple.
