## PROPOSED VISIT TO CUERDEN VALLEY PARK TRUST

We are proposing that Year 4 will visit Cuerden Valley Park Trust in Bamber Bridge on, Class 4AH Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November and Class 4BR on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2023. The educational purpose and proposed activities of this visit are as follows:

- a) To carry out field work with river investigation.
- b) Pond dipping.
- c) To identify human physical/features.
- d) Classification of organisms.
- e) To begin learning about water cycle.
